Ciara: I really enjoyed P7. My favourite part was Benmore because I took on many challenges and it was really fun!



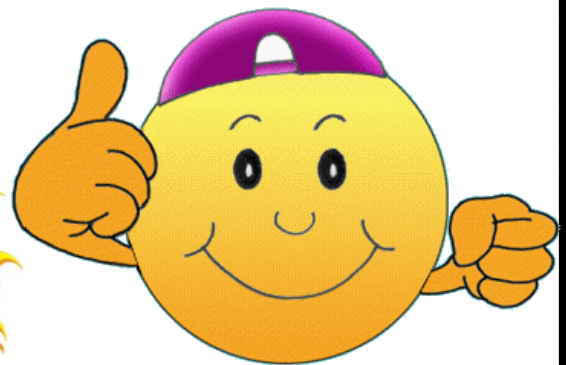
