For those who couldn't make it here's a rundown of what we hope to do in the near future.

We have an Art specialist visiting us on a Wednesday and our Music specialist on Thursdays. We are also fortunate to have Mrs Pringle teaching French. We also have P.E twice a week, on Mondays and Wednesdays. Can you ensure that your child always has the correct P.E kit with them (black shorts, plain t-shirt and indoor shoes).

This term our topic will be looking at the lives of William Wallace and Robert the Bruce and their role in shaping Scotland's future.

We are having a big focus on our Reading and Spelling skills using strategies to help us become better at both. The children will also be learning their Times Tables, we are going to start on the 2 and 10 and then move on as soon as they are confident with those. We are practising our number skills counting backwards, forwards and focussing on firstly addition skills then subtraction. We are also exploring Data Handling where the children will make a graph to record their results.

Homework is given out on a Monday and should be handed in on Thursday morning. The children should learn their spelling words by copying them out 3 times using the SACAWAC method (saying, covering, writing and then checking they have written it correctly. We are waiting on passwords and the children can then access the Sumdog website for some Maths work, and occasionally they will be given a topic based task to complete.
